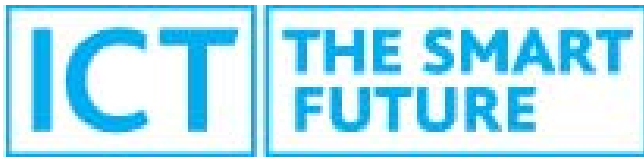
The company head office is based in Christchurch and currently employs 20 staff.
